## REQUIREMENTS FOR BECOMING AN ALTAR SERVER

Your family must be registered as parishioners of St. Gabriel of the Sorrowful Mother Parish (if you are not, it's easy to do; just ask your parents to speak with Father Anthony), and you must now be a student in  $4^{th}$ ,  $5_{th}$ ,  $6_{th}$ ,  $7^{th}$ , or  $8^{th}$ , grade.

**Email Access**: Once you signup to be an altar server, the St. Gabriel of the Sorrowful Mother Coordinator will send you email where you can specify when you will be on vacation and unable to serve,.

Vacation and Substitutes: If you know you will be unavailable to serve on specific days due to family vacations or other obligations (sports, etc.), let the coordinator know in advance of each schedule posting; you will not be scheduled on those days. If for some reason you are unable to serve a Mass for which you've already been scheduled, you must try to find a replacement. If you are unable to find a replacement, notify the coordinator. If you are attending Mass and are not scheduled to serve but there are no servers or short a server please volunteer. There will be extra albs in the sacristy for emergencies.

Service Hours: You may count your Altar Server Hours for Confirmation and other service hour requirements.

Attend training sessions. ALL TRAINING TAKES PLACE IN THE CHURCH. You will learn all the items used in Mass. You will receive a tour of the Church and Sacristy. You will be given step by step instructions on how to serve Mass. One training session required but welcome to attend both trainings as a review.

**Server Albs:** You will be able to take your alb home each time you serve. We ask that you help defray the cost of the alb with a \$25 donation.
